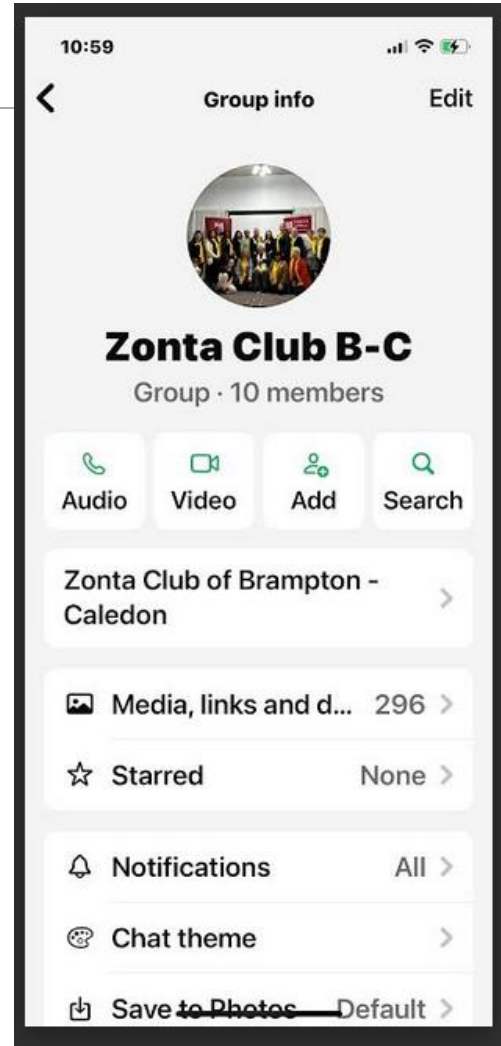



**POLICY:** In order to connect with likeminded community groups and agencies, and increase our visibility as a club that actively works to build a better world for women and girls, the advocacy team will financially support our members attending events with the following considerations in mind.

- Events must be in or directly connected to the community we serve
- Events and the agencies or groups must align with the Zonta mission and vision
- The cost of the event must be within with budget allotment
- As budget allows, 2 members may attend to represent the club and be subsidized up to 50% of the ticket cost. *\*If the ticket price is tax receiptable, only 50% of the receiptable amount to be expensed*
- Additional members may attend at their own cost.

The Advocacy Committee may request additional funds to be allocated from the proceeds of advocacy events if needed.

**PROCESS:**

Potential events are sent to the chairs/co-chairs of the Advocacy team to vet for criteria (above), to be shared with the advocacy team in a timely manner, by email or zoom meeting.

Events that meet the criteria will be posted in the Tree or Branch where all members have a chance to apply for attendance within a tight deadline.

Members who put their names forward by the deadline, must ensure that they are available for the event and that they agree to wear yellow identifiers (scarf) and to actively engage at the event to make connections for possible partnerships or membership, they should also be prepared to share information about the event with the club. As the budget allows, up to 2 people will be funded @ 50% for ticket price.

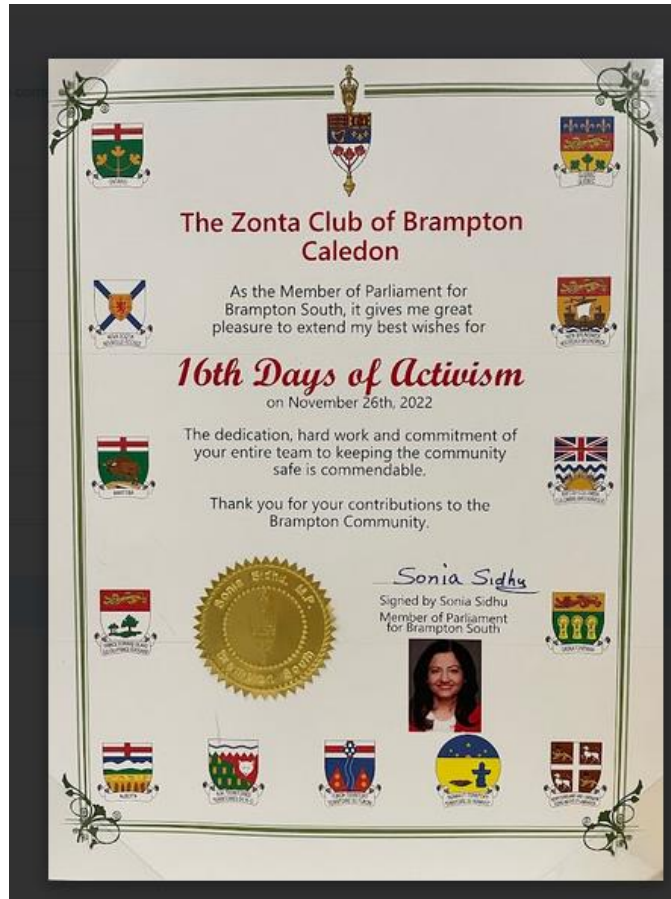
